GETTING TO & AROUND JASPER NATIONAL PARK

BY RAIL

VIA Rail runs year-round to and from Vancouver and Toronto.

Rocky Mountaineer runs seasonally from mid-April to mid-October to and from Vancouver.

BY SHUTTLE

Sundog Tours offers daily service between Jasper and Edmonton.

Brewster Express offers daily service between Jasper and Lake Louise, Banff and Calgary from May to October.

Local Public Transit has stops in the townsite of Jasper and at several attractions and campgrounds.

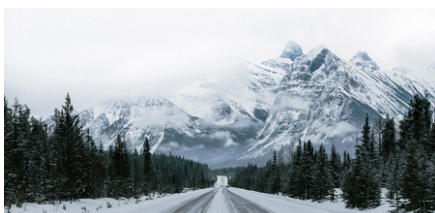

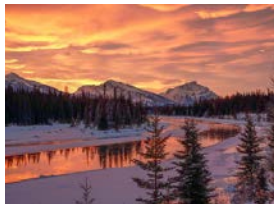

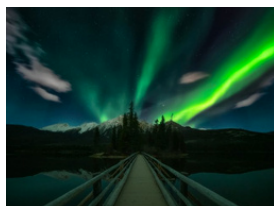
